- Any type of camera or mobile phone can be used.
- File size must be no more than 4MB and consist of the entrant's name and a title e.g. "yourname_surname_storm.jpg"
- You are encouraged to submit a short caption (max 100 words) for each image submitted. The caption should include date, time and place of the photograph and any relevant meteorological context.
- Post-capture software manipulation of images such as cropping, panorama 'stitching' and contrast adjustments are permitted, but not to the extent that a submitted image does not fairly represent the original scene. If significant software manipulation has been undertaken on the image, please include details in the caption.
