Access: Conference Auditorium 2 is the building behind **The Edge Sport Center**, at the University of Leeds. This is most easily accessed by the Willow Terrace Road Entrance to the University, off Calvery Street.

The conference Auditorium is marked as 100 on the campus map.

Travel to conference centre:

Train: 25 minute walk from Leeds Train Station, or 5-10 minutes by taxi.

Car: Leeds also has three Park and Ride locations with direct access into the city centre:

Inner-city parking: the nearest parking available is:
Woodhouse Lane, Leeds, LS2 3AX

Woodhouse Lane Car Park is Pay and Display - Parkmobile is also available at this location. Use the [Parkmobile app](#) or call 0113 809 0000. Unfortunately guest parking is

extremely limited within the university itself, and there is an automated fine for cars parked within the university without a permit so please use this carpark at Woodhouse Lane.

Accommodation: There is a wide range of accommodation available in the city centre next to where the conference centre is located at the university campus (LS2 9DA). There is also Leeds Dock – South Bank, a cosmopolitan area (~ 20 minute walk), and options in surrounding residential areas: Headingley, Meanwood, which have more access to greenspace (~35 minute commute by foot).

Luggage and Cloak Room
